Calera's 2011 Chardonnay Central Coast is super-impressive, especially for the money. A textured, inviting wine, the 2011 boasts gorgeous depth and tons of finesse. Deeply expressive varietal notes wrap around the creamy finish. — Antonio Galloni

2011 CHARDONNAY CENTRAL COAST

Calera's 2011 Central Coast Chardonnay is made from grapes grown by the following selected vineyards in California's Central Coast Viticultural Area:

Zabala Vineyard	Monterey County	279
Lone Oak Vineyard	Monterey County	209
Laetitia Vineyard	San Luis Obispo County	169
Vigna Monte Nero Vineyard	Monterey County	159
Pedregal Vineyard	San Benito County	149
Cienega Valley Vineyard	San Benito County	59
Besson Vineyard	Santa Clara County	39

After hand harvesting, the whole grape clusters were pressed and the juice was moved by gravity to Calera's barrel cellar.

Fermentation in barrels by native yeasts was followed by complete malolactic fermentation. The wine was aged without racking in French oak barrels, 10% new, for ten months. The separate vineyard lots were combined prior to bottling.
