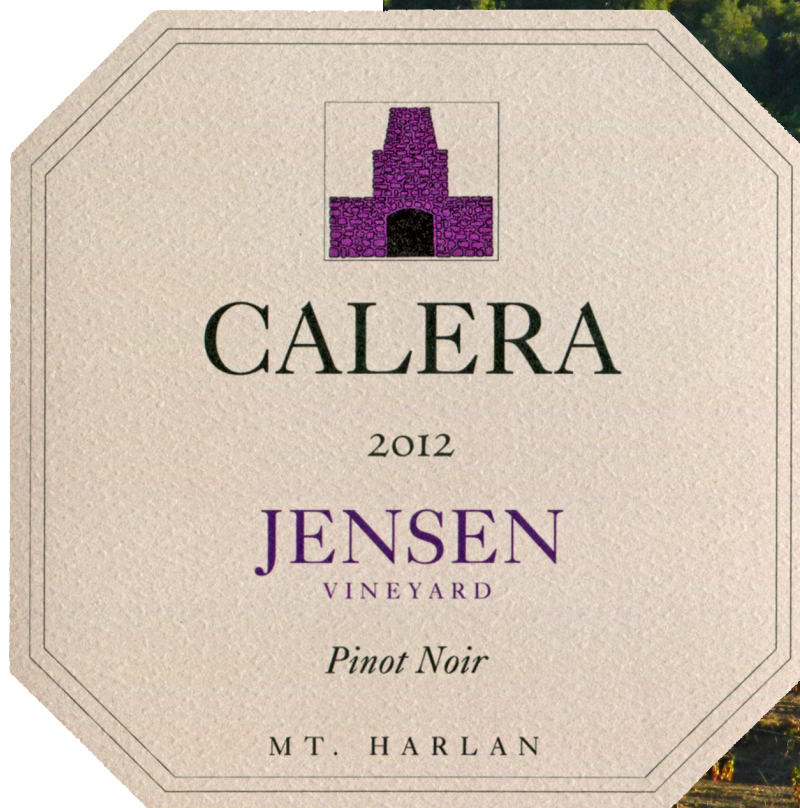


“The **2012 Pinot Noir Jensen Vineyard** hits the palate with a rush of fruit. **Intense, layered and voluptuous** in the glass, the 2012 boasts **gorgeous mid-palate depth and pliancy**. Raspberry jam and bluish-hued fruit come forth in abundance. The Jensen is **bold, racy and pungent** today. Of course, much of that forward personality will soften with age as the aromatics develop, but I expect the Jensen will always be a relatively overt Pinot. There is more than enough tannin and structure underpinning the fruit to suggest the Jensen will drink well for another 10-15 years, perhaps longer. **This is the most opulent of the Calera 2012s.**”
