Josh Jensen planted the Mills
Vineyard in 1984, his highest
vineyard at altitudes between
2,200 and 2,300 feet. The vines
grow on their own roots and
often produce Calera's most
impressively structured pinot.

This 2006 is lean and taut when first poured, marked by high acidity and brisk fruit. The texture grows fleshy with air, revealing a core of plump strawberry flavor surrounded by firm, grippy tannins.

Balanced for the cellar, this will become more complex after eight to ten years.



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
