The bright, piercing flavors typical of this Burgundian variety get a little extra kick of California richness and intensity to balance things out. This is a striking white from Calera.”

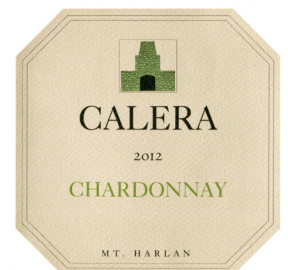
