

Light red. Smoky, intriguingly pungent aromas of cherry, red berries and baking spices, with a subtle underbrush quality. Old World in style, with distinctly meaty true pinot character, salty minerality and a vaguely austere quality. Sappy redcurrant and cherry qualities linger on the long, silky finish, which leaves a refreshingly bitter note of Campari behind. Pretty wild stuff. — *Josh Raynolds*
