2010 Calera Pinot Noir Ryan Vineyard

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A larger scaled, structured effort that oozes kirsch, strawberry, raspberry, incense and liquid flower-like aromas and flavors, the 2010 Pinot Noir Ryan Vineyard hits the palate with a full-bodied, voluptuously textured feel before firming up considerably on the finish with layers of tannin. It's a beauty, but needs 2-3 years of bottle age and will shine through 2025+.
