More tight and focused, with less overt Viognier qualities, the 2012 Viognier Mt. Harlan gives up impressive white peach, citrus blossom and tinges of minerality to go with a focused, clean and layered feel on the palate. Aged 10 months in 30% new French oak, it should blossom with another handful of months in bottle, and shine for 1-2 years.
