

If you love strawberry, sweet cherry, rhubarb, and chalky notes, check out Calera's full-throttle, amazingly fresh yet intense, dark salmon-colored 2009 Vin Gris Pinot Noir. Two of my favorite roses of the season come from the Central Coast ... this one from Calera and the Tablas Creek 2009 Rose. The vivid aromatics are followed by a well-endowed rose that is almost a shock to one's sensitivities given the number of vapid roses in the marketplace. Drink this beauty over the next 1-2 years.
