# Pinot Noir Sta. Rita Hills Bloom's Field 2023

#### 95 points | \$105 | 727 cases made | Red

Mulberry and raspberry fruit leads the way in this red, with flashes of iris and hibiscus peeking in. There's a rapier of fresh acidity for spine while bay leaf, savory and wet slate notes add underlying tension throughout. The lovely pinpoint finish has a steady persistence. Best from 2026 through 2038.—J.M.

## Pinot Noir Sta. Rita Hills Memorious 2023

#### 94 points | \$100 | 452 cases made | Red

This has a distinct density—showing intensity without heaviness—as its core of red and black cherry fruit bristles with grilled savory and flint notes. A very racy underpinning through the finish leaves echos of kirsch and wet slate. Very distinctive. Best from 2026 through 2036.— *J.M.*

# Pinot Noir Russian River Valley George Menini Estate 2023

#### 95 points | \$95 | 870 cases made | Red

This is vivid, bristling with crunchy acidity that helps drive a mix of mulberry, black cherry and raspberry fruit along, while letting in rose hip, hibiscus and pomegranate accents along the edges. Expressive and well-defined, this is brimming with energy. Best from 2026 through 2035.—*J.M.*

## Pinot Noir Russian River Valley Fraenkle Cheshier Vineyard 2023

#### 94 points | \$95 | 280 cases made | Red

Lively energy carries a vibrant mix of mulberry, red and black cherry and boysenberry flavors along, while vivacious violet and hibiscus accents gild the edges prettily. The mouthwatering finish brings you back quickly for more. Best from 2026 through 2033.—*J.M.*

# Pinot Noir Sta. Rita Hills Sanford & Benedict Vineyard 2021

#### 93 points | \$54 | 132 cases made | Red

A pure, sleek and steady wine, with a stylish beam of raspberry and cherry puree notes flanked by light red tea and singed sandalwood notes. A subtle savory echo chimes in as the fruit flows through the finish. Drink now through 2031.—*J.M.*

# Pinot Noir Russian River Valley 2023

#### 93 points | \$80 | 10,170 cases made | Red

This has solid, punchy drive, with pomegranate, cherry and blood orange pâte de fruit flavors in the mix, along with hibiscus and lilac notes. Stays fresh and engaging through the finish. Best from 2026 through 2031.—*J.M.* 



#### CHÂTEAU DOISY DAËNE

#### **Barsac L'Extravagant 2022**

#### 95 points | \$220 / 375ml | 80 cases made | White

Bright, slightly high-toned and pure, this delivers a beam of white peach, Meyer lemon and green almond that is lengthy, poised and sleek in feel. Honeysuckle and salted butter notes gild the finish liberally. Drink now through 2050.—*J.M.* 



#### CHÂTEAU SUDUIRAUT

#### Sauternes 2022

#### 95 points | \$72 | 3,324 cases made | White

A plump, broad style, with marzipan, toasted almond and bitter orange notes leading the way for mango, creamed peach and papaya flavors. Rich and honeyed, but with an alluring, shimmering energy through its long finish. Drink now through 2045.—J.M.

# Pinot Noir Russian River Valley Garbro Ranch 2023

#### 93 points | \$50 | 255 cases made | Red

This has nice succulence right from the start, with blood orange, pomegranate and damson plum coulis notes that stretch out nicely while lilac and iris accents chime in. Ends with a bright finish. Best from 2026 through 2031.—*J.M.*

# Pinot Noir West Sonoma Coast 2023

#### 93 points | \$80 | 2,400 cases made | Red

This has lovely juicy energy, with hibiscus-laced black cherry and mulberry fruit that drives along nicely, infused through the finish with black tea and a sparkle of anise. Well-defined, pure and almost breezy in feel. Drink now through 2028.—*J.M.*

# CHÂTEAU LAFAURIE-PEYRAGUEY Sauternes Crème de Tête 2022

#### 95 points | \$165 | 200 cases made | White

Creamed Anjou pear, warm tarte Tatin and apricot chutney notes result in a broad and muscular feel, while singed brioche, bitter almond and papaya fill in through the finish. Dense and youthfully backward. Best from 2028 through 2045.—*J.M.* 



#### CHÂTEAU CLIMENS

#### Barsac 2022

#### 94 points | \$NA | 50 cases imported | White

An enticing white, with lively notes of graham cracker, pie crust and ginger tossed in with glazed pear, clove-studded orange and apricot flavors. The deliciously unctuous finish offers lingering hints of bitter almond and green tea. Drink now through 2045. — J.M.



#### CHÂTEAU DE MYRAT

#### Barsac 2022

#### 94 points | \$48 | 1,666 cases made | White

A flattering style, with toasted almond and coconut notes infusing a core of candied pineapple, dried apricot and just-baked peach. Brioche and ginger details fill in liberally on the finish. Sémillon, Sauvignon Blanc and Muscadelle. Drink now through 2045.—*J.M.* 



#### **CHÂTEAU GUIRAUD**

#### Sauternes 2022

#### 94 points | \$60 | 4,166 cases made | White

Juicy and fresh, with a mix of delightfully ripe peach and yellow apple fruit that plays nicely with honeysuckle, ginger and jasmine through the finish. Exotic in bent, with lovely energy. Sémillon and Sauvignon Blanc. Drink now through 2040.—*J.M.* 



#### **CHÂTEAU SIGALAS RABAUD**

#### Sauternes 2022

#### 93 points | \$58 | 804 cases made | White

This is lively, with juicy apricot, nectarine, Anjou pear and honey flavors that have good energy and inner brightness. Green fig and candied lemon peel notes add range on the finish, which shows a toasted coconut echo as well. Sémillon and Sauvignon Blanc. Drink now through 2042.— *J.M.* 



#### CHÂTEAU DOISY DAËNE

#### Barsac 2022

#### 94 points | \$70 | 80 cases imported | White

A bright white, with freshly sliced pineapple, candied lemon peel, orange blossom and elderflower honey notes seamlessly entwined. There's a pretty accent of salted butter on the generous finish. Sémillon and Sauvignon Blanc. Drink now through 2045.—*J.M.* 



#### CHÂTEAU DE RAYNE VIGNEAU

#### Sauternes 2022

#### 93 points | \$50 | 450 cases imported | White

Juicy and frankly ripe, with mouthfilling apricot, peach and guava flavors laced with a hint of green fig. Ginger and pie crust notes add range on the flattering finish. Sémillon and Sauvignon Blanc. Drink now through 2040.—*J.M.*

# Cabernet Sauvignon Puente Alto Don Melchor Vineyard 2022

#### 95 points | \$185 | 3,500 cases imported | Red

Elegant, nuanced and concentrated, with a loamy-clay cast to the fresh thyme and subtle tuberose aromas, which give way to a rich yet balanced core of blackberry and cassis notes lifted by saline-edged acidity. Wonderfully fresh while moving toward the finish, where the flavors come together and linger harmoniously around well-formed tannins. Drink now through 2040.—A.R.

# La Parcelle 8 Vieilles Vignes Apalta 2021

#### 94 points | \$180 | 500 cases imported | Red

Elegant and fresh in feel, this medium-bodied red delivers layers of heliotrope, olive and herb details. Blackberry and plum flavors swell with intensity, adding subtle cedar, graphite and cassis notes. The spice-filled finish offers refined tannins. Cabernet Sauvignon. Drink now through 2036.—A.R.

# Don Maximiano Founder's Reserve Aconcagua Valley 2021

#### 94 points | \$100 | 1,278 cases made | Red

Savory and sage notes pave the way in this refined version, with white pepper accents to the vibrant raspberry and cherry core, enlivened by fresh acidity. Details of cassis and truffle weave in and linger as this moves to the finish line around well-integrated tannins. Cabernet Sauvignon, Malbec, Petit Verdot and Carmenère. Drink now through 2035. —A.R.

#### VIÑEDO CHADWICK

#### **Puente Alto 2022**

#### 95 points | \$390 | 300 cases imported | Red

This complex and multilayered effort lures you in with fresh violet, crushed fennel seed, damp earth and graphite aromas that give way to a rich, commanding and well-defined core of black cherry, plum and cassis. A subtle saline edge checks in, lending a mouthwatering quality as this moves to the lengthy finish around dense, structured tannins, plus late echoes of dried mint and bay leaf. Cabernet Sauvignon and Petit Verdot. Drink now through 2040.—A.R.



#### VIÑA ALMAVIVA

#### Puente Alto 2022

#### 94 points | \$180 | 1,200 cases imported | Red

This complex red slowly reveals itself, beginning with opening notes of dried violet, cedar wood and turmeric that give way to a dense core of ripe blackberry and cassis, with hints of tobacco leaf and graphite underneath. There's plenty of structure, plus a gentle nudge of acidity to let the flavors play out on the chocolatey finish, with dense yet integrated tannins. Cabernet Sauvignon, Carmenère, Cabernet Franc and Petit Verdot. Drink now through 2038.—A.R.

# Cabernet Sauvignon Maipo Valley Casa Real Reserva Especial 2022

#### 94 points | \$120 | 500 cases imported | Red

Restrained but poised for a long future. With time, this reveals mahogany, tobacco and dried sage details, yet there's a tremendous presence on the palate. Offers concentrated plum and raspberry flavors that swell around its lively acidity, adding layers of dark chocolate as this finishes around fine tannins. Best from 2026 through 2036. —A.R.



#### **CASAS DEL BOSQUE**

# Cabernet Sauvignon Maipo Valley Gran Bosque Private Reserve 2021

#### 93 points | \$60 | 200 cases imported | Red

Floral, spice and cassis accents reveal this red's plush and concentrated core of creamed plum and black raspberry, offset by piquant red chili and lively details of pomegranate and molasses. Finishes with earthy, smoky chocolate notes and integrated tannins. Drink now through 2035.—A.R.



#### **CONCHA Y TORO**

# Chardonnay Limarí Valley Amelia Quebrada Seca 2023

#### 93 points | \$55 | 682 cases imported | White

A complex and layered white, with spiced pastry, toasted almond and verbena notes that join an energetic, lingering core of clove-laced baked apple and grilled lemon. Finishes with nice length and a salty, minerally freshness centered on the core flavors. Drink now through 2028.—A.R.

# Brut Rosé Anderson Valley L'Ermitage 2019

#### 95 points | \$115 | 460 cases made | Rosé

A gorgeous sparkler that's flush with character yet elegant and refined, with lovely, crisp strawberry and red apple flavors laced with gingerbread, roasted nut and rose petal tones that sail on the lovely finish. Drink now through 2030.—*T.F.* 



#### **CLOS APALTA**

#### Le Petit Clos Apalta 2021

#### 93 points | \$65 | 1,800 cases imported | Red

Refined and structured, offering plenty of graphite and herbal notes up front that give way to a dark chocolate-coated blackberry and spiced plum center, with a twinge of cassis underneath. The tannins show some grip, but the finish also gives a sense of freshness as the core flavors linger nicely. Carmenère, Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot and Cabernet Franc. Best from 2026 through 2036.—A.R.

#### 94 points | \$70 | 596 cases made | White

A seductive and expressive sparkler, with notes of yeast roll, lemon, baked apple and toasted, spiced nuts that sail on the dry but luxurious finish. Drink now through 2027.— *T.F.*

#### 93 points | \$55 | 585 cases made | White

Precise and alluring, with elegantly layered apple, citrus, blanched almond and lemon custard flavors that finish on a refreshing, steely accent. Chardonnay and Pinot Noir. Drink now.—*T.F.*

#### 93 points | \$80 | 1,512 cases made | Rosé

Graceful and delicate, with pretty flavors of rose petal, strawberry, fresh ginger and spices that sail on the long and lovely finish. Chardonnay and Pinot Noir. Drink now.— *T.F.*

#### J. Schram Noirs North Coast 2015

#### 94 points | \$150 | 1,765 cases made | White

Opulent and almost extravagant in style, with rich flavors of baked apple and Asian pear accented by cherry, brioche, roasted hazelnut and toasty spices that linger on the crisp finish. Pinot Noir and Chardonnay. Drink now through 2027.—*T.F.*

Bright and fresh but with an appealing sheen of maturity, this sparkler offers Asian pear, roasted almond and cinnamon brioche accents that build richness on the lush finish. Drink now.—*T.F.* 





#### Sangiovese-Cabernet Sauvignon Toscana Poggio al Tufo Rompicollo 2021

91 points | \$21 | 7,000 cases imported | Red

Tasting Note:
Black currant, blackberry, iron, tapenade and mint aromas and flavors highlight this thickly textured red. Firm and elegant, showing all the characteristics of Cabernet Franc. Ends long. Sangiovese and Cabernet Sauvignon. Best from 2026 through 2035.—B.S.

## **CLOS APALTA**

#### Apalta 2021

96 points | \$170 | 1,500 cases imported | Red

#### Chile

Aromatically complex and intriguing, this offers a spiced plum pastry note that melds with petrichor, pine, dried violet and cocoa powder elements. The palate is round and richly textured, with Szechuan peppercorn accents to the concentrated black cherry, plum and cassis center. Everything comes together harmoniously on the finish and lingers, with present but integrated tannins. A stunner that should develop nicely in the cellar. Carmenère, Merlot, Cabernet Sauvignon and Petit Verdot. Drink now through 2040. From Chile. —A.R.

## Pinot Noir Sta. Rita Hills La Côte 2023

96 points | \$155 | 653 cases made | Red

#### California

Thyme, sage and savory notes spike a core of intense griotte fruit, while flashes of pomegranate, damson plum and blood orange work their way in as well. The long, mouthwatering finish has a terrific chiseled feel, with a wet flint note as its energy source. Best from 2026 through 2040. From California. —J.M.

## Pinot Noir Sta. Rita Hills Sous Le Chêne 2023

96 points | \$165 | 98 cases made | Red

#### California

Sage brush, thyme and pepper notes give this a bristling feel up front, while the core of pomegranate, blood orange and bitter cherry waits in reserve. There's a lovely racy feel through the finish, with a sanguine note twanging brightly, adding length that lets the fruit slowly flesh out. For the cellar. Best from 2026 through 2040. From California. — *J.M.* 



#### CHÂTEAU COUTET

#### Barsac 2022

95 points | \$50 | 5,400 cases made | White

#### France

Ripe, unctuous and deliciously rendered, this pumps out orange blossom, peach, apricot and pineapple upsidedown cake notes that are seamlessly stitched with bitter almond and orange threads. Offers a long, seductively glazed finish. Sémillon, Sauvignon Blanc and Muscadelle. Drink now through 2045. From France. —J.M.
