

Chardonnay, the 2007

Mt. Harlan, was cropped at a meager .9 tons of fruit per acre. An unmistakable bouquet of **liqueur of rocks** intermixed with notions of **white peaches**, white currants, quince, and honeysuckle is followed by a **full-bodied, rich** Chardonnay. It is one of the strongest efforts to emerge from this site in a number of years. Consume it over the next 4-5 years.”
