Rather than pushing for richness, Josh Jensen has created an elegant wine that needs hours of air to develop. The tannins are initially hard, the acidity youthful, the fruit delicate but persistent in its fresh cherry tone. With air, it grows increasingly complex and vibrant, a bold statement from a vineyard where pinot noir has something significant to say. Most significantly, perhaps, is that it shows a lot of potential to develop and, with decanting, is already a pleasure to drink. (729 cases)
