
Planted at 2,200 feet with a southern exposure, Calera's Mills Vineyard produces a richer style of pinot than the Ryan, with a similar salty minerality. For now, it's wrapped in toasty oak flavors that take several hours to integrate.

When they do, a bright berry fruit character emerges, supported by tannins that feel earthy and powerful. Built for the cellar (five to eight years), or give it plenty of air and serve with grilled pork chops.
