



“Moderately saturated medium red. Fresh strawberry and raspberry, incense, smoked meat and forest floor notes on the nose; smells like Chambolle-Musigny on the Moray line. Then very ripe, sappy and spicy, with dusty red berry flavors nicely framed by lively acidity. Finishes with dusty tannins, a stony nuance and very good length. An impressive debut release from this vineyard, reportedly from fruit cropped at barely a third of a ton per acre. 90 points.”
