If you prize subtlety in pinot noir, you'll want this in your cellar. At first, this is herbal, predominated by vegetal tones, but they quickly evaporate, leaving a delicate raspberry flavor. The evolution slows, taking hours to show off layers of minerals, a marine element, a dark, smoky length. It's more about savory earth tones than direct fruitiness, and has the inner strength to live and evolve for ten years or more. (207 cases)
