
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CALERA WINE COMPANY 2004 Pinot Noir **SELLECK** Vineyard



The **2004 Pinot Noir Selleck Vineyard** possesses a **deep, dark garnet/ruby color** in addition to dense, forest floor aromas **reminiscent of a DRC Richebourg or Grand Echezeaux. Extraordinarily complex** notes of truffles, berries, and damp forest are both **enticing and profound**. This full-bodied, **rich, long, compelling** Pinot Noir can be drunk now, but it will be even better with 2-4 years of bottle age. It should keep for 12-15 years. **It is stunning stuff!**
