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“Bright medium red. Dried cherry and illicit herbs on the nose, with suave floral and smoky mineral qualities adding complexity.

Tightly wound redcurrant and cherry flavors are underscored by dusty minerals and given grip by fine-grained tannins.

Finishes brisk and spicy, with a strong note of botanical herbs. This reminded me of a traditional Morey Saint-Denis.”
